

Confirmation Visits and Stoles

Dear Parents,

It has been a long-standing tradition of DUMC that the parents make a special stole as a gift to their Confirmand. This stole will be hand-crafted (mostly) by you and presented to him/her during the Confirmation ceremony. **As you can imagine, it is very important that children have a stole from their parents on Confirmation Sunday.**

During the month of February & March there are several days for you to come to the craft area and make a stole. It takes an hour to make the stole. I have attached the times that are available. Please do not bring your Confirmand with you to make the stole. This is a gift from the parents to the youth as they begin their journey as church members. During the Confirmation service you will place this stole on your son or daughter, so it is important that each Confirmand has one.

All instructions, patterns, and materials will be provided, but please bring a protective apron to wear over your clothes. We will try to have the workshop staffed for your assistance whenever possible.

We appreciate your cooperation as we work together to make this experience meaningful for both you and your child. If you are unable to attend any of the stole-making appointments, please contact the youth office at 770-394-0674 extension 104.
