

## TRINITY TABLE – Sunday, March 17, 2019

Each Sunday, Trinity Table serves a seated, hot lunch meal to approximately 250 individuals in the Capitol Hill neighborhood. Guests of the kitchen also receive a to-go meal as well as access to hygiene kits, clothing and blankets, and other donated items. DUMC serves twice a year.

This is a church-wide event for families of all ages; but it is recommended that each child under 13 is matched with an adult who will closely watch them. (You may want to bring activities or snacks for them).

Dress is casual. Many families are needed to physically serve, or provide materials prior to the event.

### The goal is to have 25-30 volunteers.

Volunteers should arrive by 11:00am.

Guests are brought into the dining room at 12:30.

Clean up starts at 2:30pm, and is usually complete at 3:00pm.

### We need supplies for 250 guests.

The hot meal will be cooked by the church: (baked chicken, rice, green beans, rolls and apple cobbler).

We have a Sign-Up Genius for these additional supplies (linked on our website).

- Divided plates (250)
- Bottled water (250 bottles)
- Peanut butter crackers (250)
- Disposable cups (250, not styrofoam)
- Lemonade mix (enough to make 60-65 gallons)
- Quart size ziplock bags we use to create hygiene kits
- 250 servings of Vienna Sausages, or Raviolis with pop-top lids
- Fruit (250 servings) Apples are not a good option because many guests have dental issues.

### We request the supplies before Sunday, March 17.

To make sure we have all the needed supplies, and arrange for their assembly, we request they are brought to the church prior to the Sunday morning we serve. There are canvas donation bins on the first floor near the soda machine, or you can drop them off at the reception desk during office hours.
