

Dear Friends,

We invite you to participate in an exciting travel/learning opportunity. From September 18-30, 2022, we will be hosting a group of pilgrims on an amazing **Wesley Heritage Tour (English Reformation)** in England. You will visit historic Methodist sites and learn of the most prominent leaders of the Protestant Reformation in England; John Wesley, Charles Wesley, Samuel & Susanna Wesley, George Whitfield and others. We will also visit **Paris, France**, where we will visit historical and religious sites.

Enclosed you will find the registration brochure outlining the study tour content and schedule. As you review the information, we want to highlight several items for you:

1. The trip dates are **Sunday, September 18 until Friday, September 30. We will be flying quality airlines (currently Delta, KLM, and AirFrance Airlines), with round-trip flight service from Atlanta to Manchester; from Paris to Atlanta.**
2. The trip is a combination of travel by plane (round-trip to/from Atlanta), bus (daily excursions), English Channel (Chunnel) train ride.
3. All of the lodging nights of the study tour will be spent in **First-Class hotels.**
4. The cost of the trip is **\$5,199 (based on double occupancy – single rooms are an additional \$950).** This price includes round trip airfare, deluxe motor coaches, all breakfast and dinner meals (including tips), (lunches will be “on our own” at designated restaurants), ground excursions, guided sightseeing, tips associated with portage at hotels, tips for guides and drivers (totaling \$120), local taxes for lodging facilities, entrance fees to sites visited, and taxes and fuel surcharges (totaling \$490). This price does not include lunches, beverages at breakfast & dinner, and personal spending for souvenirs and resources.

Persons who register for the tour will be encouraged to participate in the Trip Protection Plan offered by Consolidated Tours (see enclosed flyer – contact Consolidated Tours for information). While the Trip Protection Plan offered by Consolidated is optional, we highly suggest you purchase coverage, which is \$636 for CFAR coverage. Standard coverage is \$424. You may purchase your trip protection from another carrier, if you wish. Protection Plan payment is due at registration.

5. There will be orientation sessions scheduled to prepare for our trip. These sessions will be held at Dunwoody United Methodist Church. Orientation dates will be shared with those who register for the tour. The orientation sessions are optional, but you will find them very helpful in understanding the content of the tour and the culture in which we travel.
6. Participants will need to be able to walk a minimum of 15,000 steps a day and climb and descend stairs and uneven ground. **START WALKING NOW!!!**
7. The total number of participants on the tour will be limited. **DON'T DELAY, REGISTER TODAY!**  
**There is a minimum of 30 and a maximum of 48 for the tour.**



### Itinerary Detail

#### September 18: Beginning Our Journey

Depart from Atlanta-Hartsfield International Airport. Travel to Paris, France and continue to Manchester, England.

#### September 19: York

Upon arrival in Manchester, we will drive to York for dinner and overnight. This afternoon, visit York with a tour of the famous York Minster. Visit St. Mary's Abby and Clifford's Tower. Tour of the city of York with some free-time to walk around. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

#### September 20: Epworth

After breakfast, drive to Epworth. This is where Samuel and Susanna Wesley raised their brood of children in the Old Rectory while he served the Parish Church for 39 years. See the Memorial Church, built with contributions from around the world. Visit St. Andrews Church. Then travel to Bristol with a stop in Coventry to visit the cathedral which was destroyed during the German Blitzkrieg and yet is a wonderful sign for reconciliation between the two countries. Continue to Bristol for dinner and overnight.

#### September 21: Bristol

Half day in Bristol. Visit The New Room in downtown Bristol. Arrange for the curator/director to meet with our group in the actual worship space, then tour the museum and Charles Wesley's house, which is a short walk. While in the downtown part of Bristol, visit The Bristol Cathedral (Wesley worshiped there, too). Continue to St. Mary Radcliffe which Elizabeth 1 called "the most lovely of all the cathedrals." Go to Kingswood to Hanham Mount. This is where John Wesley and George Whitfield first began Preaching outdoors. Dinner and overnight.

#### September 22: Bath

This morning, we will leave Bristol for Bath. Half a day tour of Bath, including Crescent and Bath Abbey. Then visit the famous Roman Baths. We will lunch on our own in Bath. Then visit the Stonehenge in the afternoon. Continue to Oxford for dinner and overnight.



#### September 23: Oxford

This morning, we will proceed to Oxford, home of the oldest university in the English-speaking world. Many famous people have been educated there including John and Charles Wesley. On our walking tour we will visit sites associated with the Wesley's including Lincoln College, Christchurch and St. Mary's Church and Windsor Castle. Continue to London for dinner and overnight.

#### September 24: London

This morning we will see the City Road Chapel, site of Wesley's home and grave. Across the street in Bunhill Fields Cemetery, Susanna Wesley is buried along with other famous persons such as John Bunyan and Daniel Defoe. We will walk Aldersgate Street. Visit "Little Britain" where Charles Wesley had his conversion experience. Visit St. Paul's Cathedral where John Wesley often worshipped. Visit London Tower with a local guide. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

#### September 25: London

This a free day. Organized options will be suggested, or you may choose a day of leisure activities. This may include additional expense.

#### September 26: London to Paris

After breakfast, we will transfer to the train station to board the "Chunnel" train which crosses underneath the English Channel and across the French countryside to Paris. Upon our arrival in Paris, we will be met by our representative and transferred to our hotel. For the afternoon, we will visit of the Louvre Museum. Continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

#### September 27: Normandy

Full day tour to Normandy. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

#### September 28: Modern & Western Paris

We will begin the morning with a tour of Paris, beginning at the Place de la Concorde, Champs-Élysées, l'Arc de Triomphe, Palais des Congrès, and Trocadero. We will stop at Palais de Chaillot and the fountains, see Radio Centre, the Statue of Liberty, Eiffel

Tower, Champ de Mars, Ecole Militaire, UNESCO, Montparnasse, Les Invalides, Grand et Petit Palais, Elysee Palace, Faubourg St. Honore, Place de la Madeleine, Moulin Rouge, Eglise de la Trinite, the Opera, and Rue de Rivoli. The Balance of the afternoon, as available, is at our leisure.

#### September 29: Paris

This a day at leisure and personal touring. Our tour escort will provide us with suggested tour options. We will have dinner and overnight at our hotel before traveling to the airport.

#### September 30: Paris to Atlanta

Transfer to the airport in time for our flight home.
