*General Conference 101 | Wednesdays; March 6, 13 & 20 | 7pm Asbury Room | A three-week introduction to how United Methodist policy is made. Taught by Dr. Phil Schroeder and ministry intern, Nicholle Hansen.

General Conference | *April 23 - May 3 | Charlotte, NC |* The quadrennial legislative meeting of The United Methodist Church in which delegates from around the world vote on issues of policy and governance (Dr. Phil Schroeder is a clergy delegate).

*Post-General Conference Family Meeting | Sunday, May 5 | 3-4:30pm | Fellowship Hall | A report on the actions taken by General Conference and how that legislation affects DUMC and the larger United Methodist Church across the world.

*DUMC Charge Conference | Monday, May 20 | 7pm | Asbury Room | The annual meeting that directs the work of our local church, including review of ministry, approval of church leadership, and recommendation of candidates for ministry.

Committee of 100 | *Sunday, June 2* | *12:30pm* | *Fellowship Hall* | An annual gathering of 100 invited guests from the membership of the church to review the direction of DUMC's ministries.

North Georgia Annual Conference | *June 13-15* | *Athens, GA* | The annual business meeting of the North Georgia Conference of The United Methodist Church.

Southeastern Jurisdictional Conference | *July 10-12* | *Lake Junaluska, NC* The quadrennial meeting of delegates from the Southeastern Jurisdiction of the US. Includes assignment of bishops.

September 1, 2024 | Church leaders approved at Charge Conference begin roles.

January 1, 2025 | Most legislation approved at General Conference takes effect.
